My debt is paid off. My credit card balances are zero.

Did I win in Vegas? No. Do I make seven figures a year? Not a chance. I learned how to play the game. I learned how to play Reality Millionaire, work with the numbers I had, and come out a winner. These steps have worked so well for me that I have spent the last seven years teaching them to others. There is no reason why everyone can't have enough for retirement or for their life's dreams.

You can do it too. In a world where personal debt is at its highest levels, where a staggering percent of divorce is caused by money troubles, and where the average American spends \$1.22 for every \$1.00 that he makes, there is a way out of the downward financial spiral.
